

1Pet. 2:11 ¶ Beloved, I beg *you* as sojourners and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul,

Sojourners - πάροικος - a stranger, a foreigner, one who lives in a place without the right of citizenship

Pilgrims - παρεπίδημος - an alien alongside, i.e. a resident foreigner

In other words when you receive Jesus, this world, earth is no longer your home. You become a foreigner in this world.



Liberty - **ἐλευθερία** – License to do as one ought, not as one pleases.

Cloak - **ἐπικάλυμμα** - covering, or veil

Vice - **κακία** - Malice, depravity

Commendable - **χάρις** – that which brings joy, pleasure, delight, sweetness, charm, loveliness: to God.

Example is a Greek word only used here. Greek - **ὑπογραμμός** - an underwriting, copy for imitation. This refers to a copy that is to be reproduced by the student. The Teacher is the original and the student is to produce the copy in their life of the teacher.

Reviled - **λοιδορέω** – to heap abuse upon, to rail at, to berate, to despise to call out hurtful words.
