

## “Heart Troubles” Part 2

“Troubled” – to cause inward turmoil, stir up, disturb, unsettle, throw into confusion or agitate

Heart (mind, will, and emotions)

Romans 7:15 New Living Translation

I don't really understand myself, for I want to do what is right, but I don't do it. Instead, I do what I hate.

1 John 5:3

For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome.

The first is the Greek word “allos”, and the second is the Greek word “heteros”

– “allos” means one of the very same kind; same character; same everything; or a duplicate.

– The second word, “heteros”, means one of another kind or one of a different kind. This word heteros forms the first part of the word heterosexual, which describes someone who has sexual intimacy with a person of the opposite sex.

“I will pray to the Father, and He will send you Someone who is just like Me in every way. He will be identical to Me in the way He speaks, the way He thinks, the way He operates, the way He see things, and the way He does things. He will be exactly like Me in every way. If the Holy Spirit is here, it will be just as if I am here because We think, behave, and operate exactly the same...”

1 John 4:1 says Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test (examine prior to approval) the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

“conformed” – means to assimilate

sense: to be or become behaviorally or socially similar to; being shaped or molded into a certain pattern

1st Peter 1:14

Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest your hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; 14 as obedient children, not conforming (assimilation) yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance; 15 but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, 16 because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."

1 John 5:18–19 Header...Knowing the True—Rejecting the False

We know that whoever is born of God does not sin (continued habitual lifestyle of sin) How?

– We keep our minds set on who we are in Jesus Christ and depend on his power and promises

but he who has been born of God keeps himself and the wicked one does not touch him "touch" means to attach one's self to; lay ahold of; get a grasp of

Satan, or one of His demons – cannot attach himself to one who is born of God.

We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one.

– That's Satan

John 8:44 gives us some facts about him

You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it.

Hebrews 4:12

"transformed" means to be changed

This Greek word is where we get our English word...metamorphous (change from within)

passive voice – The grammatical voice that signifies that the subject is being acted upon. The subject is the receiver of the verbal action.

2 Corinthians 3:18

But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

renovation – to restore to a former better state (as by cleaning, repairing, or rebuilding or replacing

Titus 3:3-6

For we ourselves were also once foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving various lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful and hating one another.

☐ That's what their conformed state looked like
