Confession – ὁμολογέω – (ho-mo-lo-ge'-o)

To say the same thing as another, to agree with.

It is where we get the word Homiletics. Homiletics is the confessing or the preaching of the word of God. So to do that you need to be in agreement with the scriptures.

Atonement – כִּפּוּר – (Kippur) – Expiation

Amends, Penitence, punishment, reparation, payment. From the root word Kafar meaning to cover.

Time of Reformation (Reformation - 1357)

To straighten thoroughly, also a time of correction.

**Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the
gospel which I preached to you, which also
you received and in which you stand,**

1 CORINTHIANS 15:1

**By which also you are saved, if you hold fast
that word which I preached to you—unless
you believed in vain.**

1 CORINTHIANS 15:2

**For I delivered to you first of all that which I
also received: that Christ died for our sins
according to the Scriptures,**

1 CORINTHIANS 15:3

**And that He was buried, and that He rose
again the third day according to the
Scriptures,**

1 CORINTHIANS 15:4

Propitiation – *ἰλάσκομαι* – (he-lä'-sko-mi)

To atone for, make reconciliation, to propitiate.
